Manual & safety instructions Stealth Gear Baghide



Delivery includes:

- Stealth Gear Bag hide
- Carrying bag

Safety first:

- The Stealth Gear Bag hide is a single-person hide, so never use it with more than one person!
- Ventilate the tent sufficiently.
- Please ensure that you do not use the bag hide under trees where branches may fall or trees themselves may fall over.
- Do not use the hide during a storm or thunderstorm.
- Do not use fire in or around the hide, do not smoke.
- Do not take any risks with fire, especially in dry natural surroundings or during drought conditions.
- Do not use this product if you are under the influence of alcohol, drugs or medication.

Getting started with the Baghide:

1. The baghide is a photohide without poles that you can throw over yourself and your equipment. It was designed so that it fits comfortably to your head, using a ring. This keeps the baghide firmly in place, while a viewing window (with insect screen) allows you to check your surroundings in front of you. The canvas is big enough to cover yourself and your tripod with camera/lens, while your photo backpack can be placed next to you or below.
2. There is a Velcro strip on the front, which can remain closed or be opened to insert a tripod leg, for example, to provide a little more space.

3. Just below the viewing window is the opening for your lens. You can close this with the cord and cord stopper at the front to ensure a good fit and seal.
